In 2022 our parent organisation changed its name from Salmon & Trout Conservation UK to WildFish Conservation. It is a wild fish charity which seeks to influence national bodies and decision makers about the conservation of fish stocks, water and the environment. It supports research projects and uses scientific evidence to support its policies. We retain our name of Hampshire Branch, Salmon and Trout Conservation and continue to be affiliated to and supported by WildFish.

The branch will help to highlight issues relevant to fisheries, water management and conservation, and help to address them to the appropriate authorities.

The branch provides introductory days for fly fishing for trout at various still water fisheries in Hampshire. These days cater for families, juniors (aged 10 - 16) and adults.

Qualified instructors are always used for these occasions, as well as using experienced fishermen. Anglers requesting individual instruction can be referred to appropriate organisations providing such tuition.

The branch frequently has stands at local shows and is always willing to help and advise members.
